

Preparing for the Support Letter Draft: A Quick Start Guide

1. Using the Grace Point church directory, **compile a list of 30 or more people to whom you could send support letters.**
 - a. If you know them, great! If you don't know them, you can still write their name down. A lot of our congregation members will gladly support any GPYM teen.
 - b. If you don't have a church directory, they will be available at the youth center visitor info wall.
 - c. Bring this list with you to the support letter draft.

2. Attend Support Letter Draft **if** you want to send letters to people within the church.
 - a. At the fundraising draft, we will take turns "drafting" names of people we can send support letters to. (Special Note: You can attempt to draft anyone except immediate families of teens in the youth group, people going on the mission trip, and relatives of those going on the mission trip or camp).
 - b. Bring pencil and paper to keep track of the people you draft. (It is recommended to have a parent/guardian present. If teen and parent cannot be there, you can ask someone to be your proxy and stand in for you.)

Don't Miss the Support Letter Draft, Sunday, February 11th, 5:30 PM to 7:00 PM in the Youth Center.

Remember! If you can't be there, you can have someone come and serve as a ***proxy*** and *participate in the draft for you.*
