After June 5th & Walk-Ins - \$200

Make checks payable to : "NEI/NYI" [No personal checks will be accepted. Please use church checks and money orders]

CAN I SEND ONE BIG CHECK FOR BOTH JR. HIGH \$ SR. HIGH CAMPS AND ALL MY FORMS TO THE SAME LOCATION?

NO! We keep separate financial and registration records for each camp. To make work easier for the directors and to yourself, please make sure to send information to the proper location.

WHEN IS REGISTRATION AND PICK UP?

Sr. High Camp registration begins no sooner than 1:00 pm on Monday, July 9th

Pick up is at 1:00 pm on Friday, July 13th

<u>WHAT ACTIVITIES WILL BE AT CAMP THIS YEAR?</u>

There will be Escape Rooms, a Paint War, Laser Tag, along with many other fun and exciting activities!

WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

Bible, writing utensil, notebook, pillow, bedding for a twin bed or sleeping bag, washcloth, towels, grooming articles (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.), socks, those unmentionables, shoes, pants, shorts, shirts, grubby clothes and shoes for getting messy, modest swimwear (girls - 1 piece or tankini that looks like a 1 piece, guys- no speedos), snacks for dorm (optional), sunscreen, modest sleeping wear, spending money for snack shack & a good attitude.

^{*}Please note to bring messy (possibly throw away) clothes, shoes, and a towel to clean up with after the Paint War*

WHAT COUNTS AS MODEST?

In order to create a safe and pure environment for teens, we ask that everyone bring modest clothing to camp. While it's hard to define what modest is, here are some basic guidelines.

MODEST CLOTHES

- No short shorts (shorts should be mid-thigh length or longer)
- No low cut or spaghetti strap tank tops
- No low cut shirts
- No exposed underwear
- No clothing that exposes breasts, butts, or midriffs
- Gender-born appropriate clothing
- No clothing with obscene/inappropriate language or suggestive themes, sayings, or pictures

MODEST SWIMSUITS

- Swimsuits should conform to the above rules
- Girls should wear a 1 piece, non-revealing swimsuit (tankini's are ok provided they look like a 1 piece). Girls can also choose to wear a dark t-shirt over the top of their swimsuit
- Guys, no speedos or swimsuits that are revealing

ARE LICE CHECKS REQUIRED?

NO! However, Shiloh Park does require that every camper be checked for fever. Upon arrival,

<u>ALL CAMPERS & COUNSELORS</u> will be checked for fever.

ARE TEENS ALLOWED TO DRIVE TO CAMP?

NO! In order for us to provide the best safety for all, a camper should not drive a vehicle to camp. Please find appropriate transportation (with church or parents) to and from camp!

HOW DO I BECOME A SR. HIGH CAMP COUNSELOR?

Counselors must be at least 21 years or older at the time of camp. All counselors must have a background check and successfully complete ministry safe training. Ministry safe is valid for 2 years and must be renewed every 2 years. Background checks are valid for 2 years. Pastoral recommendations will be conducted. Counselors should mail their ministry safe certificates and proof of background checks, along with their camp counselor form filled out correctly to:

ATTENTION! PLEASE READ!

Due to the rapid change of our world, there has been modifications made by Shiloh Park, such as in insurance policy and security adjustments, to better protect and keep those attending camp safe. Senior High Camp strives to make our camp the safest place possible, so there have been some updates to those who are being allowed onto Shiloh Park property during the times of our camp.

What are the changes:

- Camp visits from anyone not staying at camp will only be allowed between 2:30 pm 6:30 pm. The
 responsibility lies on the visitor to be off the campgrounds by the designated time, otherwise
 future visitor privileges will be lost
- All visitors will have to report to the Shiloh Park camp office to sign in and receive a visitor badge, which must be worn at all times while on Shiloh Park property until visitor(s) sign out and leave.
 Visitors must sign in and out each time they enter or exit the campground property
- All visitors must submit a background check (completed within the past 2 years) that has no discrepancies. All background checks must be on file with the Senior High Camp director no later than June 5th
- -Other exceptions need to be approved by Senior High Camp Director beforehand (there are many last minute preparations that take place, please plan ahead and don't wait until the last minute to get approval, as it may not happen)
- Due to expenses, food provided for the campers will not be available to any visitors. Please have visitors plan to bring their own food and eat in the cafeteria if they plan to stay that long
- Reminder: Anyone without the appropriate documentation on file by the June 5th deadline given <u>WILL NOT</u> be allowed on Shiloh Park property
