Frequently asked questions

What should I bring?

Bedding for a twin bed or sleeping bag, toiletries, towel, clothes that are modest, sunglasses, two sets of clothes that you don't mind getting messy, swimsuit (girls-one piece or long tankini; boys-no speedos), sunscreen, tennis shoes that you don't mind getting wed/dirty, bible, notebook/pen, snacks for the dorm (optional), spending money for snack shack (optional).

Are lice checks required?

Yes, Shiloh park requires that every camper be checked for lice. Teens can be checked for lice beforehand, or they can be checked by camp staff upon arrival. Students who already have their hair checked for lice will get through registration faster.

Can I bring my phone?

Yes. However, your usage time will be greatly limited. Camp is intended to bring a different pace and routine to life and unlimited access to electronics distracts from that goal for our campers.

Electronics such as cell phones, cameras, music players, and gaming devices are **only permitted for use during allotted times** which are to be set by the director/coordinator of each event. NEI-NYI will **not be responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged devices**. At any point, we (event director/coordinator) reserve the right to confiscate any electronic device if leadership determines the device is being misused, causing distraction, or used excessively. Item(s) will be stored in a safe location and returned at the conclusion of the event.

On the occasion that any electronic device is used, resulting in the violation of a person's privacy or the capturing of pornographic images (regardless of intent), parents will be notified and authorities will be contacted to handle the investigation. Use of photographic devices in restrooms and living quarters are forbidden and failure to comply will result in indefinite suspension from ALL District NEI-NYI related events pending review by the District NYI President, the event/ director coordinator, and any other parties deemed necessary by the District NYI President.

This policy is to ensure the safety and protection of our students, leaders, and NEI-NYI.
